West and Central Europe and Central Asia where HPAI in wild birds has been diagnosed, increases the chances that birds overwintering in West Africa's wetlands, rivers, and shorelines may transmit the disease to local wild birds, and from there to domestic poultry This transmission pattern has been identified in other regions

West Nile Virus Infection - Iowa State University

West Nile virus (WNV) is a mosquito-borne virus that circulates among birds, but can also affect other species, particularly humans and horses Many WNV strains are thought to be maintained in Africa; however, migrating birds carry these viruses to other continents each year, and some strains have become established outside Africa
